- Worked with 61 pediatric health providers and nonprofits Partners to service 1,221 families with critically and chronically ill children
- Provided 360 Getting Started Medical Binders to parents near the onset of their child’s serious diagnosis to help them navigate a difficult road
- Held 5 six-week support groups with Bible Study via zoom, 1 with in-person option
- Had 107 volunteers serve 604 hours of time
- Worked with partners to hold two Special Needs Moms Nights Out and Mom’s Hike & Picnic to connect families to one another
- Participated in partner’s event by serving families at a Special Needs Trunk or Treat
- Held our annual Summer Family Picnic including food, games, and professional family portraits
- Continued offering professional counseling to special needs children, their siblings, and parents who demonstrated a financial need
- Provided 26 Hospital Comfort Bags to families
- Continued our work with Face It to prevent child abuse in special needs children by providing materials we helped develop and discussed with parents at each touching point
- Continued work with MOPS International to provide support to special needs families nationwide including a workshop at their national conference
- Wrote new curriculum, filmed and produced teaching videos for Building Family Unity While Navigating Special Needs Bible study we developed in partnership with Redefine Special
- As an addition to above mentioned Bible study, a second version was developed to be used with equine therapy partners: Building Unity in Special Needs Families
- Met one on one with parents to support them and provide resources
- Helped provide Inclusion Education training for 480 students at two Louisville area schools to teach typical children to appreciate differences in special needs peers with partner Skool Aid
- **All services provided at no cost to families**

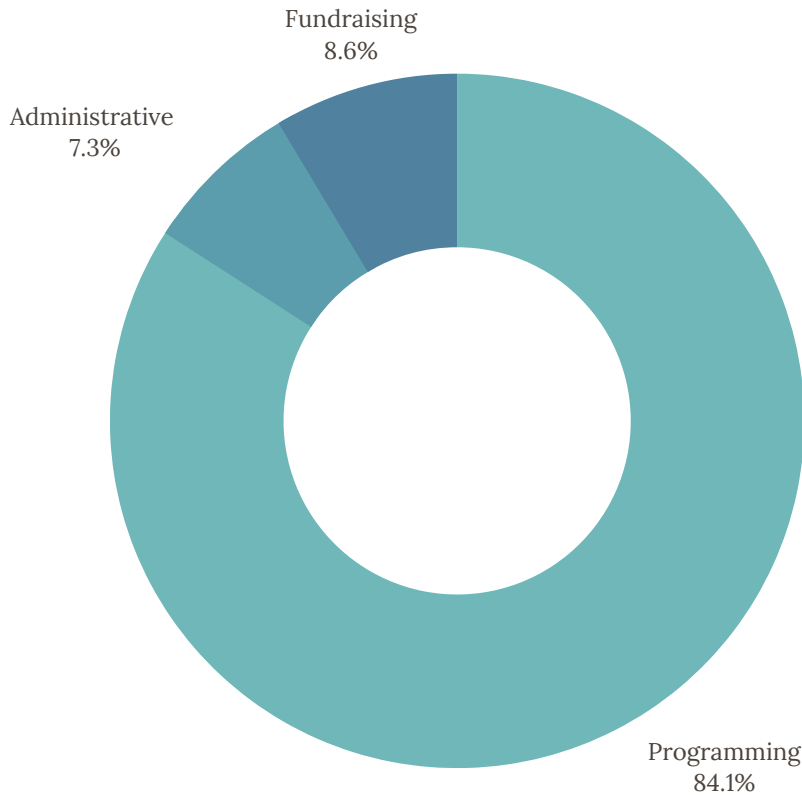
