2023 CRITICALLY LOVED FAMILY PICNIC

### **2023 IMPACT**

- Worked with 68 pediatric health providers and nonprofits Partners to serve 1,559 families with critically and chronically ill children
- Provided 383 Getting Started Medical Binders to parents near the onset of their child's serious diagnosis to help them navigate a difficult road
- Held seven 5-9 week support groups with Bible Study via zoom and in person
- Had 101 volunteers serve 408 hours of time
- Worked with partners to hold two Special Needs Mom's Night Out Events and Mom's Hike & Picnic to connect families to one another
- Participated in events with our partners by serving families at a Special Needs Trunk or Treat with FEAT and Louisville Prayer Walk with New Day Ministries
- Held our annual Summer Family Picnic including food, games, and family portraits
- Continued offering professional counseling to special needs children, their siblings, and parents who demonstrated a financial need
- Provided 54 Hospital Comfort Bags to families
- Continued our work with Face It to prevent child abuse in special needs children by providing materials we helped develop and discussed with parents at each event
- Continued work with The Mom Co, by MOPS International to provide support to special needs families nationwide including a pampering workshop at their national conference in Chicago, IL
- Held workshops at 2 additional national conferences with Team Luk3 in Austin, TX and Key Ministries in Cleveland, OH
- Utilized new curriculum, Building Family Unity While Navigating Special Needs Bible study, we developed in partnership with Redefine Special by holding Bible studies
- In addition to above mentioned Bible study, the second version developed to be used with equine therapy partners, Building Unity in Special Needs Families, was launched with the pilot program at Green Hill Therapy
- Met one on one with parents to support them and provide resources
- Helped provide Inclusion Education training for 2,300 students at 7 Louisville area schools to teach typical children to appreciate differences in special needs peers with partner Skool Aid


